### **Location and Times**

#### **Saturday Morning Session**

6 and Under, 7-8, and 9-10 age groups  
Warm Ups: 7:00 AM (Warm-ups will be 15-20 minutes/session)  
Meet Starts: 8:00 AM  
Morning Session Ends: About 11:30 AM

#### **Saturday Afternoon Session**

11-12, 13-14, and 15-18  
Warm Ups: Not before 12:00 PM  
Afternoon Session Starts: Not before 1:00 PM  
Meet Ends: About 5:30 PM

### **Eligibility**

A swimmer must be a member of the team he/she represents and therefore must meet the membership requirements of that particular team.

A swimmer must have competed in two (2) official MVSA sanctioned meets. An official MVSA meet is one where there have been at least the first 40 events completed.

### **Proof of Participation**

In accordance with the MVSA By-laws, it is the responsibility of each team to be able to prove that their participating swimmers have met eligibility requirements. It is advisable that each team representative bring copies of meet results from all league meets to show that a swimmer has participated in at least two meets.

### **Entries**

Swimmers may be entered in no more than three (3) individual events and two (2) relays. Swimmers must swim individual events in their age group (based on their age as of June 1 of the current year). Swimmers can swim up in age groups for relays.

In the Butterfly, Breaststroke, and Individual Medley events, teams are limited to entering no more than four swimmers. Entries for Freestyle and Backstroke events are unlimited. Team entries for relays are also unlimited.

## **Meet Rules**

Basic rules for the meet can be found in the MVSA By-Laws available on the MVSA website ([www.mvsaohio.org](http://www.mvsaohio.org)). In addition, the following rules also apply:

1. Only swimmers, meet officials, session volunteers, and coaches are allowed on the pool deck. Absolutely no spectators will be allowed on deck.
2. For the morning session, a clerk of course will be used and all swimmers must report to the clerk of course. Swimmers must also have their last name and first initial written on the back of their shoulder using indelible marker to aid the clerk of course workers. For the afternoon session, there will be no clerk of course. Swimmers must report directly to the blocks.
3. For the morning session relays, the second and fourth swimmers must start their leg of the relay in the water.

Relay Events:	Ribbons for 1 <sup>st</sup> through 8 <sup>th</sup>
Heat Winner Ribbons:	Given to all heat winners in the morning session
Age Group Awards:	Flags will be given to all age group winners
Team Awards:	Banners given for 1 <sup>st</sup> through 7 <sup>th</sup> place

## **Heat Sheets**

Heat sheets will be sold in the lobby. Separate heat sheets will be available for each session.

## **Parking**

Parking is available in all campus parking lots and on the street where the curb is not painted yellow. The YMCA parking lot adjacent to Hermann Court is reserved for handicapped parking only. Parking is not permitted on Elm Street or in the circle by the Hugh Heiland Theatre.

## **Spectator Balcony**

There is ample observation area in the balcony but only if spectators use it only for watching the meet. Unlike prior championships at Wittenberg, there are only three rows of seating so making a permanent “residence” in the balcony will only inhibit other parents from being able to watch their children swim. Ample room will be available in the Hermann Court basketball arena.

## **Swimwear Vendor**

Kast-A-Way Swimwear will be at the meet, housed in a corner of the gym.

## **Event Listing**

Please note that the event listing (on the next page) is numbered differently than at league dual meets. Since the younger swimmers begin the meet, their events begin at #1 and go through #32. The afternoon session begins with event #33 and ends at #80. Events are swum in the same order as during a dual meet, just the numbering changes.
